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Subject: Banana price announcement from Fairtrade International Standards & Pricing

Dear partners,

On 18 and 20 September 2024, the Standards Committee of Fairtrade International approved the new Fairtrade Minimum Prices for bananas, which will be valid for contracts with producers from the 1st of January 2025. The minutes of the Standards Committee meeting will be published on our <u>web page</u> as soon as they are approved.

Table 1 at the bottom of this letter, presents the Fairtrade Minimum Prices that will be valid from the 1st of January 2025 (indicated in **bold black text**). Please note that the table also includes the existing Fairtrade Minimum Prices, which are valid until the 31st of December 2024 (indicated in gray text).

The Standards Committee decision includes FOB Fairtrade Minimum Prices for different loading ports for some banana producing countries.

To support banana stakeholders working with the Fairtrade Minimum Prices approved by the Standards Committee, Fairtrade International publishes the following tools and tables:

- a) a prorate tool together with the <u>explanatory document</u> on how to use the tool, to calculate the Fairtrade Minimum Price for bananas with a different weight than the 18,14kg. You can access to the prorate tool for special carton boxes by clicking <u>here</u> and for IFCO crates by clicking <u>here</u>. You can also find the <u>explanatory document</u> on how to use the prorate tool.
- b) a list of reference costs, updated to August 2024, for the key eight inputs and services of the banana production, three out of eight at Ex Works level (basic wages, fertilizer, fuel) and five out of eight at the FOB-Ex Works differential (standard carton box for 18.14 kg of fresh fruit, Banavac, pallets, inland freight and port charges). These costs are taken as initial reference when setting the Fairtrade Minimum Prices. The costs of these eight inputs and services are available on our website here.

The Fairtrade Premium is paid in addition to the price, whether it is: a) the market price (which applies if higher than the Fairtrade Minimum Price), b) the negotiated price (negotiated to be higher than the Fairtrade Minimum Price) or c) the Fairtrade Minimum Price. The Fairtrade Minimum Prices and Premiums are also published in the Database on our website at http://www.fairtrade.net/price-and-premium-info.html.

²Ex Works is defined as the location of the producer where palletisation is executed, and bananas are not cleared for export and not loaded in any collecting vehicle. At Ex Works level, prices include labour costs for packing (including palletisation) only to prepare the bananas for loading on the collecting vehicle (truck or container). Ex Works prices do not include any kind of packing material.

³Free on Board (FOB) prices include costs for the following packing materials: a) standard carton box, b) one plastic per carton box (banavac or polypack), c) pallet, d) edge corners, e) strips and f) up to 3 labels per banana hand. The costs for these standard packing and palletisation materials are covered by the exporter. However, the service related to packing (labour costs) of above defined standard packing material is included in the Ex Works-prices and provided by the producer.

Neither the Ex Works nor the FOB prices include costs for additional or special packing materials such as "cluster bags" or "parafilm" and related service. Costs for those packing materials and any associated labour must be paid on top of the Fairtrade Minimum Prices to producers at Ex Works or FOB level and be defined in the contract. FMP in any case refer to 18.14 kg of ripened fruit. If boxes with different weight are used, FMP and Fairtrade Prices are calculated pro rata.
